In India, education consists mostly of lectures, presentations, and laboratory activities in the classroom. Audio-visual aids such as projectors, stereo systems, and film projection are used to supplement them. E-learning does not appear to be replacing traditional classrooms with blackboards, but rather coexists alongside the current system. This strategy is unlikely to reach India's rural areas, where education remains a looming gloom. This goal can be met by supplying low-cost PCs with broadband connections. In India, the scope of e-learning is much broader, with several e-learning businesses offering the service. In India, the e-learning scene is still developing and in its early stages.

The inevitability and challenging situation of post Covid pandemic times have transformed the psyche and temperament of the U.G. Hindi Language Teachers to develop e-content of their subject and got mastery over this trend. Yet there are some challenges in developing e-content like Technology dependent, Material Incompatibility, Unsuitable for certain type of students, expensive, reliant on human support, No match for face-to-face teaching, too reliant on IT skills, disabilities etc.,

Technology is a tool that can and should be efficiently harnessed and used in the classroom. E-learning is well adapted to distant and flexible learning, but it can also be used in conjunction with face-to-face instruction, in which case the phrase Blended learning is widely used. E-learning does not appear to be replacing traditional classrooms with blackboards, but rather coexists alongside the current system.

In conclusion, E-Content Development in Hindi (Optional) at UG Level in pre-Covid period was not so productive and played not so vital role by the faculty members of college teachers. In Covid-19 pandemic period the Hindi teachers accepted all the odds and obstacles, trained themselves well and learned to develop e-content in Hindi. They are even well versed in LMS.
